

Planning to Apply for OSAP?

Below are things you may need to complete the application:

Your personal information

- Social Insurance Number (SIN)
- Student number
- Date you last attended high school full-time (not upgrading)
- Date you last attended post-secondary
- Course load %
- Income tax line 15000 from your 2021 income tax assessment
- Estimate of your income from all sources for your academic year

Sole-support parent

- Your personal information
- Child(ren)'s date of birth
- Child care cost for children under 12 or if the child is 12 years and older and has a documented permanent disability

Parent(s) information

If you are single, you will have to provide parental information unless:

- You have been out of high school for at least four years
- You have been full time in the work force for 24 consecutive months since leaving high school
- You are a current or former crown ward receiving ECM
- Both your parents are deceased

Parent(s) information continued

If your parents are separated or divorced, the parent with whom you currently live, or who last supported you, must complete the parental section and sign the declaration pages. If that parent is remarried or living common law then you will need the following information for both parents:

- Parent(s) full name
- Parent(s) date of birth
- Parent(s) Social Insurance Number (SIN)
- Parent(s) postal code
- Parent(s) income line 15000 from their 2021 income tax assessment
- Parent(s) EI contribution line 31200
- Parent(s) CPP contribution line 30800 & 31000
- Parent(s) tax payable line 43500

Married/Common Law

You are common law if you have been living together in a conjugal relationship for three years or more or if you and your partner are the natural or adoptive parents of the child(ren) you are raising together.

- Partner's Social Insurance Number (SIN)
- Marriage or common law date
- Partner's income line 15000 from their 2021 income tax assessment
- Partner's EI contribution line 31200
- Partner's CPP contribution line 30800 & 31000
- Partner's tax payable line 43500
- Partner's date of birth
- Partner's date he/she last attended full-time high school (not upgrading)
- Your child(ren)'s date of birth
- Child care cost for children under 12 or if the child is 12 years and older and has a documented permanent disability

Remember: You are responsible for reporting any changes to your application to the Financial Aid Office
