



Study Permit Extension: Online Eligibility Questions

When you begin your application for a **study permit extension**, you will need to:

1. Log into or create an [online IRCC account](#).
2. Respond to a series of “Eligibility Questions” so that the system can identify what type of application you need to submit. Below is a guide to some of the appropriate answers for the eligibility questions. Please note that this is not a complete list and you should answer all questions accurately according to your particular circumstances, if they differ from the recommendation below.

Questions	Answers
What would you like to do in Canada?	Study
How long are you planning to stay in Canada?	Temporarily – more than 6 months
Select the code that matches the one on your passport.	Select the code as per your passport
What is your current country/territory of residence? If you are presently in Canada, you should select Canada.	Canada (<i>if you are currently inside Canada</i>)
Do you have a family member who is a Canadian citizen or permanent resident and is 18 years or older?	Yes or No, depending on your situation.
What is your date of birth?	Enter your date of birth as mentioned in your passport
Do you have a provincial attestation letter?	No
Do you qualify for an exception?	Yes
Which exception do you qualify for?	I am an applicant who meets another exception listed on the IRCC website
Are you a lawful permanent resident of the United States with a valid alien registration card (Green Card)?	Yes or No, depending on your situation.
What is your current immigration status in Canada?	Student (<i>if your study permit is still valid; if it is not currently valid, email for guidance on your restoration application at internationaladvisor@confederationcollege.ca</i>)
What is your marital status?	Answer as per your situation
What is your province of destination?	Ontario
Select ‘Study Permit (in Canada)’ to continue	
Do you also want to apply for a work permit?	Yes, I wish to apply for a Co-op Work Permit (<i>choose this if your program has a co-op</i>). If your program does not have a work-integrated learning component, <i>then you can answer no</i> .
When does your status in Canada expire?	<i>Enter your study permit expiry date.</i>
Have you had a medical exam performed by an IRCC authorized panel physician (doctor) within the last 12 months?	Yes or No, <i>depending on your situation. If yes, you will be prompted to submit a confirmation of the medical examination.</i>
A medical exam... Do you fit into one of these categories?	Yes or No, depending on your situation.

Do you want to submit an application for a family member?	Yes or No, <i>depending on your situation. Review the definition of family members and note that you can only submit an application here for a family member <u>that is currently inside Canada</u>.</i>
Are you giving someone access to your application?	No (<i>unless you have hired an immigration professional to submit your application for you</i>).
In the past 10 years, have you given your fingerprints and photo (biometrics) for an application to come to Canada?	Yes or No, <i>depending on your situation. If no, you may be required to submit them.</i>
There are fees associated with this application. Will you be paying your fees or are you fee exempt?	Yes, I will be paying my application fees. <i>There are very few exemptions from paying these fees.</i>
Are you able to make digital copy of your documents with a scanner or camera?	Yes
Will you be paying your application fees online?	Yes
