Confederation College's Academic and Career Entrance Program (ACE) can help!

Ontario residents 19 and over can enrol for free if they meet the eligibility requirements. ACE courses and the ACE Certificate are recognized as grade 12 equivalent by all Ontario public colleges and many employers across the province.

College upgrading (ACE) students can:

- Complete one or more ACE courses to satisfy specific prerequisites for application to college postsecondary programs
- Use a combination of high school courses and ACE courses to satisfy prerequisites for college postsecondary programs
- Complete the ACE Certificate requirements to obtain a grade 12 equivalent certificate for apprenticeship or employment, or postsecondary programs requiring the full certificate.

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Academic & Career Entrance (ACE)

Admission Requirements

- 19 years of age or older (some exceptions may apply)
- Resident of Ontario
- Eligible to work in Ontario
- Applicants are admitted to this program based on program eligibility requirements and assessment results.

ACE Certificate Requirements (Grade 12 Equivalency)

To earn the ACE Certificate, you are required to complete the following courses:

- ACE Communications
- ACE Core Mathematics
- Any two additional ACE courses listed below

The ACE program operates year round and has continuous intake (students can start anytime).

ACE – On-campus Option

This program offers the flexibility of full-time or part-time hours of study, allowing you to complete your Academic Upgrading or ACE certificate (Grade 12 Equivalency) by working and learning in a classroom environment with on-site faculty.

On-campus option also offered at the Greenstone Campus and Marathon Campus.

ACE – Distance Education Option

This program offers the flexibility of full-time, part-time and flexible hours of study, allowing you to complete your Academic Upgrading and/or ACE Certificate (Grade 12 Equivalency) by working and learning on a computer via the internet.

Exemptions

Students who complete ACE Academic Communications and apply to a Confederation College postsecondary program are automatically exempted from CS050-College Writing.

Each student is assessed to determine the level of mathematics, communications and/or science for placement in our courses. This will help us to create an individualized training plan just for you.
