- Qualifications:**
- Must be a full-time post-secondary student at Confederation College in the 2024-2025 academic year (minimum – attending entire winter 2025 semester). Full-time is defined as having a minimum 60% course load, or 40% if you have a permanent disability.
 - Must be returning to Confederation College as a full-time post-secondary student in September 2025
 - Must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident protected person, or an international student who is legally eligible to work in Canada.
 - If domestic, must be approved for OSAP, or complete the [needs score spreadsheet](#) to demonstrate a financial need

- Duties:**
- Under the direct supervision of the Aviation Technologists attached to the AT_AM program, the student assistant will be responsible for:

 - Assist with job lists from each faculty member for each shop/lab for the following semester
 - Each list will have material to be sourced, ordered, prepared for semester training aids
 - Nine different shops/labs that require material or repairs
 - Repositioning of aircraft and engines (this is tricky without the help of a student assistant as
 - more than two people is a minimum for moving these items)
 - Set up shops/labs and organize – prep for Fall semester
